EMPLOYMENT FOR 10,000 ENGINEERS PEACEFUL MARCH

Wednesday, 27th August 2025

On Katiba Day, The Institution of Engineers of Kenya (IEK), led by President Eng. Shammah Kiteme, CE, FIEK, presented a petition to H.E. Dr. William Samoei Ruto, PhD., C.G.H., President of the Republic of Kenya, calling for the immediate creation of 10,000 job opportunities for Engineers across various sectors of the economy.

This historic presentation, coinciding with the President's declaration of Katiba Day, was preceded by a Peaceful March of Engineers in Nairobi, symbolizing the profession's commitment to nation-building while highlighting the urgent unemployment crisis facing Kenyan engineers.

Key Proposals to Unlock 10,000 Jobs

The petition outlined practical interventions that could rapidly generate engineering jobs while strengthening Kenya's industrial and infrastructure development:

- **Infrastructure Projects** – Prioritize local engineers in major projects and ensure foreign

contractors employ and fairly compensate Kenyan engineers.

- **Industrialization Drive** – Fast-track infrastructure and industrial funding, implement local content policies, and lower the cost of doing business to stimulate private-sector absorption of engineers.
- **Roads Sector** – Enforce a one-project-per-Resident Engineer (RE) policy, immediately creating an estimated 1,500 jobs while enhancing quality assurance.
- **Energy Sector** – Ring-fence contracts for local firms, a move projected to generate 2,000 jobs, particularly in power transmission and installation.
- **Affordable Housing** – Expand consultant participation, review professional fees, and involve engineers in materials management, creating 4,000 new jobs.

- **Water Sector** – Implement dam and water pan projects, particularly in ASAL areas, unlocking 1,000 opportunities for engineers.
- **Aviation Infrastructure** – Expand JKIA and build two new airports, generating 500 jobs in design, supervision, and construction.
- **Agriculture, Irrigation, Blue Economy, & Railways** – Invest in irrigation schemes, complete and extend the SGR, and modernize agriculture to create 1,000 more jobs.
- **Sugar Belt Industries** – Reserve artisan, technician, and technologist roles for Kenyans, protecting over 1,000 opportunities.
- **Fair Compensation & Regulation** – Conduct a nationwide audit of foreign firms to enforce equitable pay and address misuse of Kenyan engineers' licenses.

Thursday, 21st August 2025

IEK at the Kenya Power Conference Thursday, 21st August 2025

The Institution of Engineers of Kenya (IEK) Council Members recently participated in the Kenya Power Conference, a high-level forum that brought together stakeholders from across the energy sector to deliberate on Kenya's power and energy future.

Representing IEK were Eng. Prof. Christopher Muriithi, Eng. Christine Ingutia (Chair, Western Branch), and Eng. Paul Otuoma (Chair, North Rift Branch). The conference was also addressed by Eng. Dr. Joseph Siror, Managing Director & CEO of Kenya Power, who underscored the utility's commitment to sustainable energy solutions and collaboration with professional engineers.

The forum focused on key themes including sustainable power generation, renewable energy integration, grid modernization, and the role of local expertise in delivering reliable and affordable electricity. IEK Council Members emphasized the importance of positioning Kenyan engineers at the

center of these national priorities, both in technical delivery and policy formulation.

Through their participation, IEK reaffirmed its commitment to strengthening professional capacity, advocating for greater recognition of local engineers, and fostering partnerships that drive Kenya's socio-economic transformation.



IEK Engages with Kumkang Kind on Modern Formwork Solutions for Kenya's Housing Agenda

Friday 1st August 2025

The Institution of Engineers of Kenya (IEK) was honored to be represented by President Eng. Shammah Kiteme alongside other IEK delegates including Eng. Maurine Auka - CEO, Eng John Kariuki Karanja - Member of the Future Leaders Committee and Grace Wanjihia at a special presentation by Kumkang Kind East Africa Ltd on their innovative Aluminium Formwork System. The delegation was received by Sam Mwhia the head of Construction Business at Kumkang Kind East Africa Ltd.

Held at Kumkang Kind's offices at The Mirage, Westlands, the event brought together leaders from the engineering, construction, and housing sectors to explore scalable technologies for Kenya's housing agenda. Eng. Kiteme joined stakeholders in discussions on how modern formwork enhances efficiency, quality, and sustainability, aligning with IEK's mission to promote engineering excellence.

Kumkang Kind, a global construction leader since 1979, has deployed its Aluminium Formwork System in 3,500+ projects worldwide, including 60,000 housing units across Africa. In Kenya, it is used in Tatu City, Tilisi, and key Affordable Housing Programme projects in Pangani, Shauri Moyo "A", Mavoko, Konza City, Jogoo Road, and Kibera.

Following the briefing, participants embarked on a site visit to the Mavoko Affordable Housing Project, where they witnessed first-hand how the formwork system is being applied on the ground. The demonstration showcased the system's capacity to accelerate project delivery while ensuring high-quality, cost-effective outcomes.



Speaking at the meeting, Eng. Kiteme applauded Kumkang Kind for their role in advancing Kenya's construction sector and emphasized the importance of engineers embracing innovative technologies that align with the nation's development priorities.



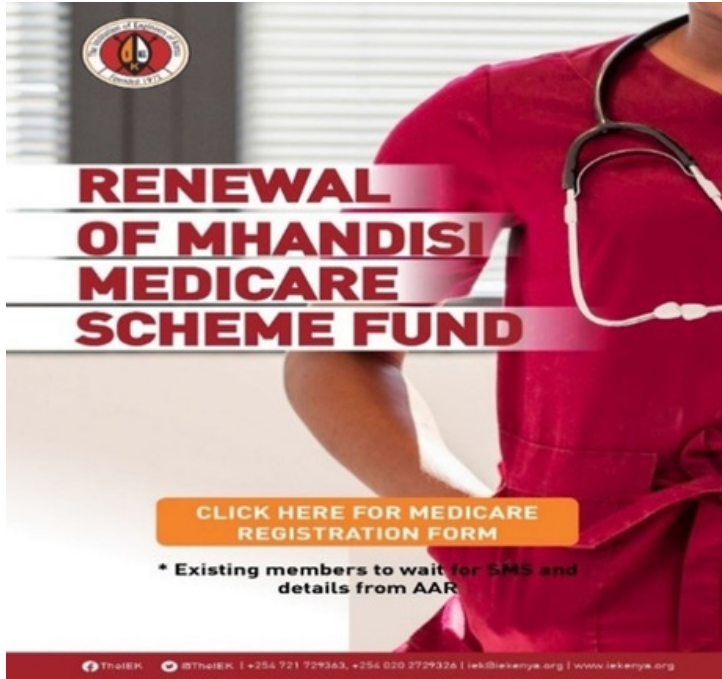

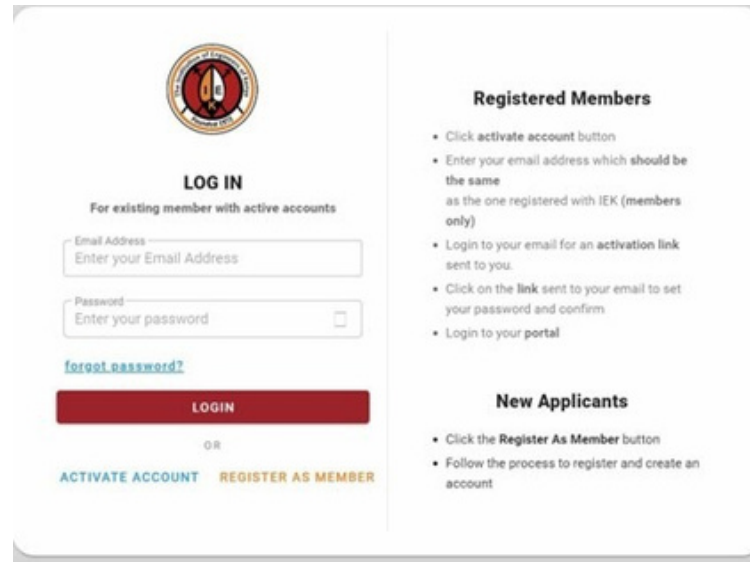
