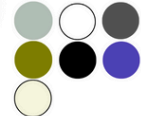

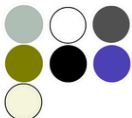

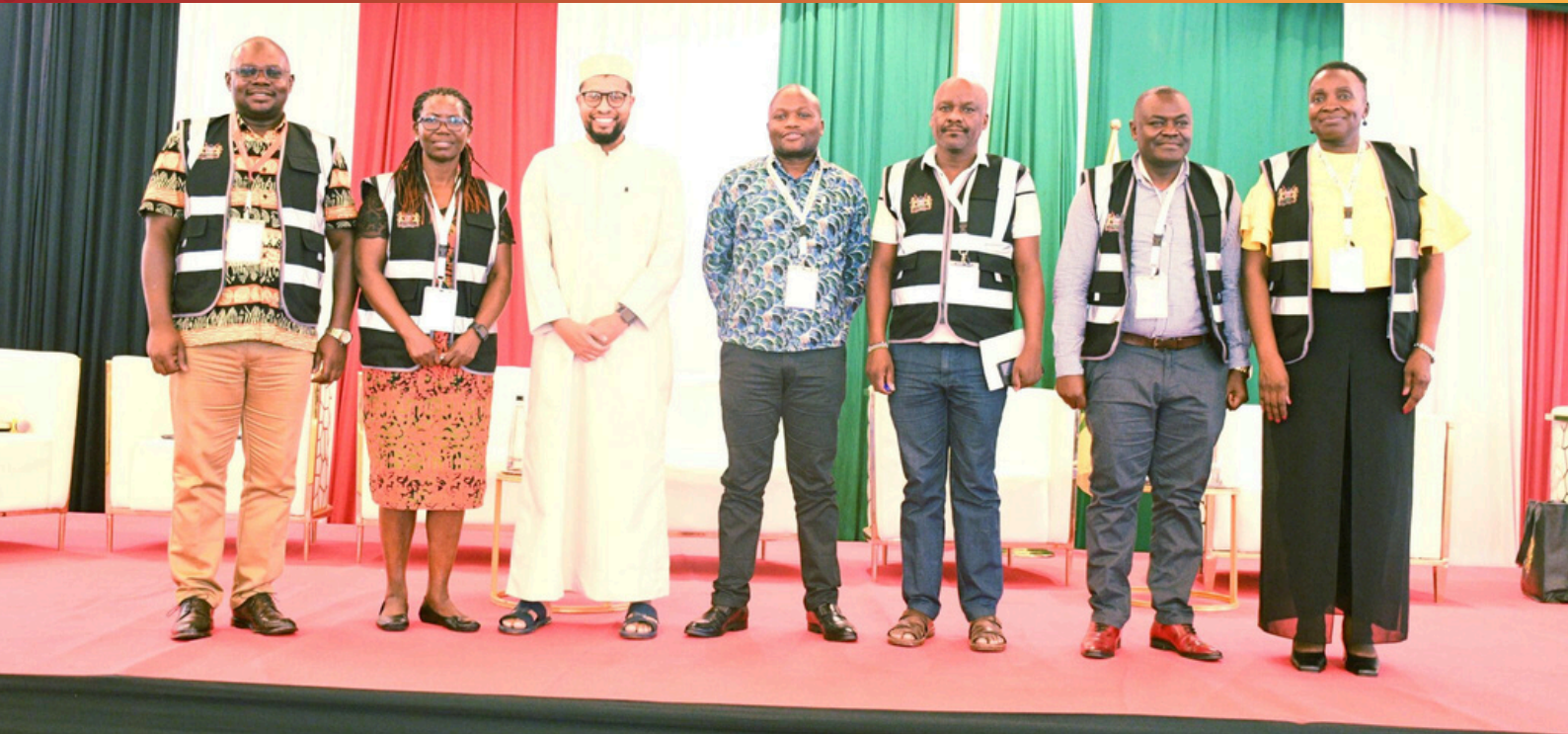
## IEK, ACEK and EBK Mentor the Next Generation of Engineers

Saturday, 20<sup>th</sup> September 2025

**T**he Institution of Engineers of Kenya (IEK), through its Future Leaders Committee, in collaboration with the Engineers Board of - and the Association of Consulting Engineers of Kenya (ACEK) Future Leaders, rolled out mentorship sessions at Murang'a University of Technology and Michuki National Polytechnic.

The forums brought together students eager to learn about the engineering profession, career pathways, and the importance of professional registration. Speakers emphasized that mentorship is not only vital for bridging the gap between academia and industry but also a cornerstone of continuous professional development.





## IEK 2<sup>nd</sup> VP Eng. Christine Ogut Champions Infrastructure Safety at Inter-Agency Road Safety Conference

Thursday, 19<sup>th</sup> September 2025

**D**ay two of the Inter-Agency Road Safety Conference spotlighted the vital role of infrastructure safety and risk targeting in - reducing accidents and safeguarding lives on Kenya's road network.

At the heart of these discussions was Eng. Christine Ogut, 2nd Vice President of the Institution of Engineers of Kenya (IEK) and a representative of the National Transport and Safety Authority (NTSA). Eng. Ogut emphasized the need to integrate safety considerations at every stage of road design, construction, and maintenance. She highlighted that risk targeting must go beyond reactive measures, urging agencies to adopt proactive approaches that identify and mitigate hazards before accidents occur. Moderated by Eng. Monica Abonyo, Acting Director of Highway Design and Safety at KeNHA, the panel brought together top stakeholders including Eng. Ezekiel Fukwo (KeNHA), Daniel Manyala (Mombasa County), Eng. Victor Odula (KRB), Eng. P.G. Githere -

(KeRRA), and Eng. Wilfred Oginga (KURA). Collectively, they underscored that collaboration between national and county governments, coupled with evidence-driven planning, is central to building safer roads.

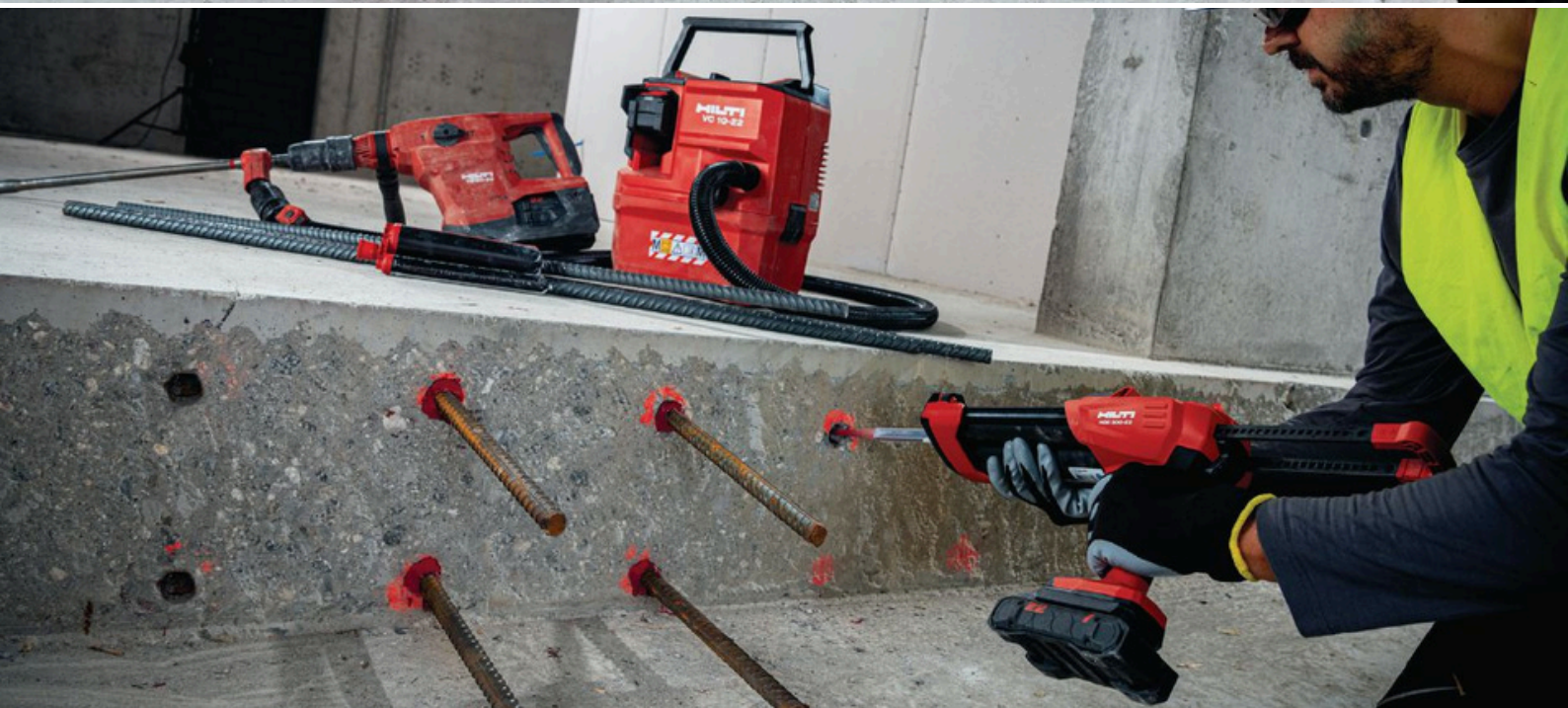

## The Engineer's Corner

Eng. James Karori Nyabuto - Operations Manager, Rox Engineering

Friday, 19<sup>th</sup> September 2025



### 1. What's something about your childhood or early life that influenced your choice to pursue engineering?

I grew up in very tough circumstances and life was not easy. Survival demanded creativity, innovation, resilience, perseverance, and hardiness. I vividly remember collecting used bottles from bars and wines and spirits joints, washing and selling them to patients who needed syrup or liquid medicine refills at Keroka General Hospital. I also made toy cars from barbed wire and sold them to the elite kids.

I therefore chose engineering because I knew it required exactly that, and most importantly, I believed it would end our struggles. And indeed, God has been faithful. The journey has not been easy, but it has been victorious.

### 2. Outside of your professional life, what activities or hobbies bring you the most joy?

I have always been a workaholic, and I am still figuring out hobbies outside work. I enjoy progressive house music and old school hip hop. Lately I am finding satisfaction and fulfillment in mentorship. Seeing my mentees grow into Professional Engineers is deeply fulfilling. So far, seven PEs have passed under my mentorship, and I could not be prouder.

### 3. Was there a project or assignment early in your career that gave you confidence you were on the right path?

I was fortunate to work on major projects early in my career, including the Standard Gauge Railway, Kigoro Water Treatment Plant, Mwea Irrigation Development, Moi International Airport rehabilitation, water projects in Uganda and Tanzania, Proto Energy LPG plants, and various buildings.

The Kigoro project was a turning point being involved in all phases, delivering a national masterpiece, and working with a multicultural team gave me global exposure. At VINCI Construction, the French team recognized my potential and helped me grow into one of East Africa's top quality and safety managers.

As Quality Manager for the Mwea Irrigation Project, I led ISO 9001, 14001, and 45001 systems, deepened my expertise in QAQC, QHSE, and FIDIC contracts, and built a strong team. Even when the project was terminated, our robust documentation safeguarded our work. Meeting the Dispute Board led by Aisha Nadar was a privilege. These experiences shaped my engineering journey, taught me to see the bigger picture, and proved the unmatched value of documentation lessons no book can teach.

### 4. You've worked across site management, quality control, and operations which role challenged you the most, and what did you learn from it?

Every role has challenges, but quality control and contract administration in mega projects are relentless. Without strong leadership and a solid team, projects can easily derail. Termination is especially tough for QAQC heads, who must ensure all evidence and documentation are airtight. Delivering airport pavements and commissioning water treatment plants was equally demanding, yet manageable.

My true baptism by fire came when I left employment to build Rox Engineering. It was brutal but transformative, teaching me financial discipline, persistence, emotional intelligence, resilience, legal insight, patience, and above all, calm under pressure.

Most importantly, it reinforced the value of a good name, consistent delivery, showing up no matter what, and never burning bridges.

**5. You've worked with many different sectors and projects. If you could switch careers for a day and try something completely different, what would you choose?**

Either a brand strategist or a fire protection engineer.

**6. As a certified Safety and Health Consultant, what's the one safety tip you wish more people knew, especially when working on big projects in construction?**

Incorporating safety in design and budgeting for safety goes a long way in minimizing incidents and accidents. Of importance, normalize conducting Pre-task toolbox talks.

**7. As Chair of the Site Inspection Handbook Taskforce, how did your past roles prepare you for this responsibility?**

My experience in analysis, design, material testing, inspections, site supervision, and quality, environmental, and safety consultancy on diverse infrastructure projects combined with international exposure prepared me to lead the team. I have coordinated with diverse engineering teams and stakeholders to develop QAQC and QHSE documentation such as quality plans, risk assessments, inspection test plans, handover documents, and task-specific checklists, many now used internationally. Leading this taskforce was a natural extension of my experience and a chance to give back to my country by raising inspection, quality, and safety standards across Kenya's construction sector.

**8. How is the handbook both reliable and usable by engineers and site inspectors in the field?**

The handbook offers a unified framework that standardizes site inspections, facilitating cross-disciplinary coordination, and promoting quality, safety, compliance, and accountability in the

construction sector. It is practical, prepared by practicing professionals, structured, and discipline specific. The checklists combine industry best practices, statutory references/guidelines, with a practical approach. It is not a shelf document, but a working companion in the field.

**9. What's a fun fact about you that would surprise most people?**

I retired with a wingman record of 100 percent.

**10. If you could pick any superpower to help you with your work, what would it be and why?**

Reading minds. Imagine always being three steps ahead of your toughest opponent... Checkmate!

**11. What childhood game or activity do you look back on with joy and would play right now if given the chance?**

Those video truck movie nights. Arnold Schwarzenegger, Rambo, Bruce Lee, Cynthia Khan, Jet Li, Van Damme, Bolo Yeung, Striker... the mobile cinemas that rolled into town once a month. The thrill, the crowd, the suspense, and praying you do not get hit by a rotten egg. Pure nostalgia. I don't see them around anymore though.

**12. If your career had a soundtrack, what song would play during your "big moments"?**

Ambition by Wale featuring Meek Mill and Rick Ross, especially Ross's verse. Ambition is priceless.
