



- Have been in leadership positions for the last nine years in professional body in the building and engineering sector. This has opened my eyes to the real issues affecting professionals in the sector as well as the broader issues affecting the industry.
- Engaging in Advocacy for solutions to challenges facing engineers; This included being in delegations engaging with policy makers and Government officials as well as lawmakers. Have participated in presentations to MPs in Parliament on laws affecting engineers. Currently as Executive Committee member in APSEA, this gives an opportunity to bring up issues at this high level for the benefit of IEK and the members for example- job opportunities in the National and County governments. Currently APSEA is providing technical assistance to IEK in reviewing the IEK Code of Conduct where IEK is among the first beneficiaries.
- Engaging in Networking and lobbying activities with relevant Government Agencies to pursue Opportunities for engineers, both graduates and corporate professionals. This include an opportunity to engage with former President Kibaki leading to increased appreciation of role of engineers in CDF Funded projects.
- Provided leadership in Public Education on the Role of Engineers, to protect Engineers reputation and to promote engagement of engineers for quality outcomes in construction projects
- Developed home-grown solutions to address the challenge of lack of opportunities for Continuous Professional Development for Engineers. This entailed running quality CPD programs in partnership with sponsors, while engaging closely with EBK to provide CPD points, prior to development of the CPD Policy by EBK now in place. Several engineers benefitted from the quality CPD programs which were free of charge for engineers.
- Mentorship - Have led and participated in numerous mentorship activities for University students and graduates of University of Nairobi, JKUAT, High School students and others.
- Public Education – Have participated in TV programs, shows and Open- to- the -Public Exhibitions to sensitize the public on role of engineers and the benefits of engaging them.

Drawing from the above position I believe I am well positioned to contribute immensely to the incoming IEK Executive Council 2020 -2022 in the area of Advocacy, Fund Raising, CPD programs, Education and Mentorship, Beneficial Collaborations and Networking.
